COVID-19 & SAFETY ON SAFARI

We are all becoming accustomed to going about our daily lives differently after the Covid-19 pandemic. Safari is no different and the safety and well being of our guests is paramount. This document outlines the new procedures to expect on your safari. anzania is already open for tourism, there is no quarantine for new arrivals. As always we recommend getting your visa online well in advance to speed up your arrival at the airport where temperature screening and health checks will be in place. A II our partners are employing strict Covid-19 protocols. Your meet and greet at the airport will not shake your hand, your vehicle will be thoroughly cleaned before pickup and your luggage will be cleaned before arrival at the hotel. Social distancing will be in place and staff will be wearing face masks. We recommend that you do so when travelling, flying and in the city.

On arrival in camp temperatures will again be checked along with strict luggage handling procedures. Staff are thoroughly trained in safety measures, interactions with guests as well as amongst themselves. Daily deep cleaning of guest rooms, communal areas and back of house is in place. Staff use appropriate PPE for cleaning and handling laundry. Hand sanitiser will be available throughout. D ining is now done separately. Plated and served. No buffets.

S hared game drives will be a maximum of four people to allow for standard social distancing. Private game drive vehicles can be guaranteed if booked in advance.
